Honorees, who must be 35 years of age or younger, are recognized for their accomplishments in at least one of the following areas:

- ❖ Distinguished service to Emory University, the Emory Alumni Association, or a constituent alumni association, school, division or department of Emory University; or
- ❖ Distinguished community or public service, or
- ❖ Distinguished service or achievement in honoree's field or profession

Letters of nomination will be accepted for 2008 through January 17, 2008. Awards will be presented at Emory Homecoming Weekend on Friday, September 26, 2008.

Supplemental information including resume of the nominee and letters of support are encouraged. **Nominations should include:**

1. Nominees name, business affiliation, and contact information (mailing address, telephone number, and email address)
2. Biographical information including nominee's relevant education, background, interests, past awards, and other recognitions
3. Contact information for individual making the nomination (name, title, mailing address, telephone and e-mail encouraged)
4. Reason for nomination, describing nominee's merits for the award. Please include key activities, accomplishments and history of employment if not noted in Bio.
